Short Message

Disruptive rain leading to localised flooding of settlements, roads, low lying areas and bridges as well as disruptions to clean-up/recovery procedures is expected in places over Dr Beyers Naude LM, Koukamma LM, Kouga LM and Nelson Mandela Bay Metro.

Discussion

A cut-off low along the West Coast of the country together with a surface trough and a high pressure system are resulting in showers and thundershowers in places over the Eastern Cape. Due to saturated soils, dams that are already overflowing and more rainfall still expected, flooding is highly possible.

Impacts

Localised flooding of roads, formal/informal settlements (including those around rivers/dams) and low-lying bridges.
 Localised disruptions to traffic and dangerous driving conditions due to slippery/flooded roads.
 Pooling of water may obscure potholes and cause accidents.
 Localised disruptions to clean-up and/or recovery procedures or plans.

Instruction

DO NOT cross flooded rivers/areas
 Road users are advised to be cautious on the roads
 Listen for regular weather updates via radio and/or social media.
 Monitor the weather conditions and if need be, identify areas to safely store valuable items away from flood water.
