Wolf Wind Farm (RF) (Pty) Ltd submitted the Final Basic Assessment Report in support of the application for Environmental Authorisation (EA) for the development of the Main Access Road for the authorised Wolf Wind Farm located near Jansenville, situated within the Dr Beyers Local Municipality and within the greater Sarah Baartman District Municipality, Eastern Cape Province to the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE) on 27 May 2022.

The applicant hereby notifies all registered interested and affected parties of the outcome of the application for EA and the Department's decision, in compliance with the requirements of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended. The Department has granted authorisation for the above-mentioned project, with the decision issued by the Department on 24 August 2022.
