The Dr Beyers Naudé Local Municipality invites tenders for the submission of rates for the upgrading of streets and stormwater in Dr. Beyers Naudé Municipality

The successful tenderer will be allocated the assignment only if and when required during the 90-day validity period, and subject to the availability of approved funding. The assignment will include the upgrading of and/or improvements to the roads and stormwater in Aberdeen and Neu Bethesda.

Tenderers must have a CIDB contractor grading designation of **5CE** or higher. The tenderers' attention is drawn to clause 4.1.1 of the Tender Data when submitting their tender. In addition, tenderers must demonstrate competence in the construction of projects using the principles of the Extended Public Works Programme either through their own experience or through a joint venture partner.

In addition, only tenderers who have access to a suitably qualified and experienced Construction Manager who will be the single point of accountability and responsibility for the management of the construction works, and who is registered with SACPCMP as Pr. CM or with ECSA as Pr. Eng. or Pr. Tech. Eng. or Pr. Techni. Eng. are eligible to tender. Provision has been made through the contract for third-party management support by the Employer in terms of the principles of SANS 1921-4: 2004.

Preferences are offered to tenderers in terms of sub-clause 5.11.8 of the Tender Data (B-BBEE Status).

Only tenderers who are registered on the National Treasury Central Supplier Database (CSD) as accredited service providers are eligible to submit tenders. Registration is permitted prior to the submission of tenders
